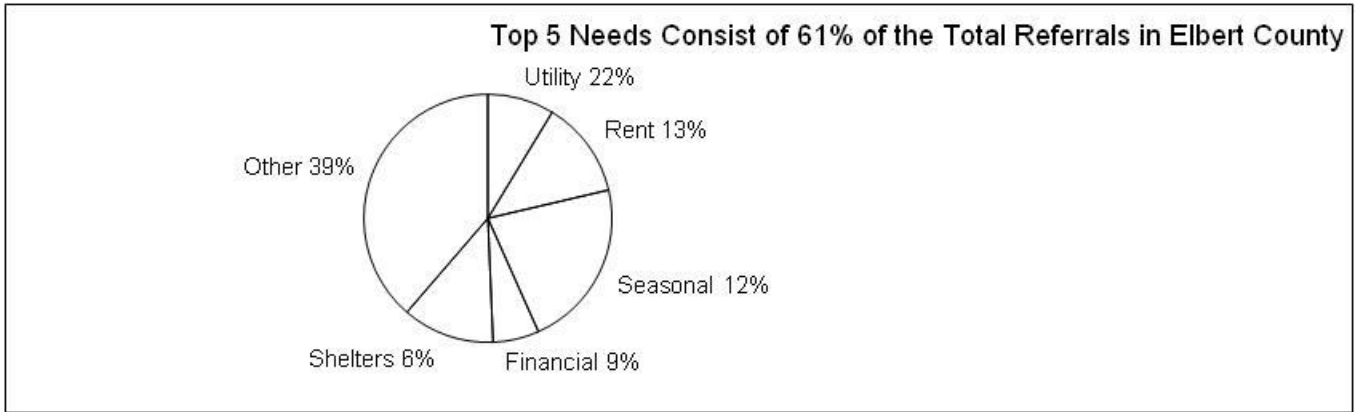

2-1-1 Caller Demographics for Elbert County

- 71% are women
- 47% are single, divorced or separated
- 38% are under 40 years of age
- 79% are Caucasian
- 69% are unemployed
- 52% annual income under \$10,000 per year (\$833 per month)
- Average income \$8,964 per year

2-1-1 Homeless Caller Demographics for Elbert County

- 25% are homeless for the first time
- 25% are recently homeless (under 30 days)
- 100% are single, divorced, or separated
- 75% are women
- 0 homeless children are under a year old
- 50% are staying with friends or relatives
- 25% are staying in hotels/motels
- 25% are from out of state
- 50% are under 25 years of age
- 60% of 5 homeless children are under the age of 5 (3 children)
