Impact Outcomes:

- Direct access to quality classrooms for 3,600 children
- Support for an innovative early learning alliance to share back-office functions in order to increase quality classroom access
- Training and resources for 160 informal and home care providers
- Professional development and education for 80 childcare professionals
- Fund organizations that assist more than 5,000 families to have the resources and skills needed to successfully support the children in their care
