Impact Investments in Youth Success will:

- emphasize proven strategies that improve academic outcomes to help low income and underserved youth graduate from high school.

Funded partners range from large organizations with a national footprint to small local providers making a deep impact in their own neighborhood.

Impact Outcomes:

- Emphasis is on strategies that improve academic achievement outcomes
 - 3,800 youth will be impacted through mentoring organizations
 - Alternative Education and Service Learning programs will impact 1,500 students.
 - After school programs will reach 13,500 youth
 - Includes increased impact in Aurora
 - The addition of the Sheridan School District
- Funding will also address
 - Parent and caregiver support for youth in the foster system
 - Advocacy for the most vulnerable and neglected school age youth
 - Workforce preparation
 - Capacity building
