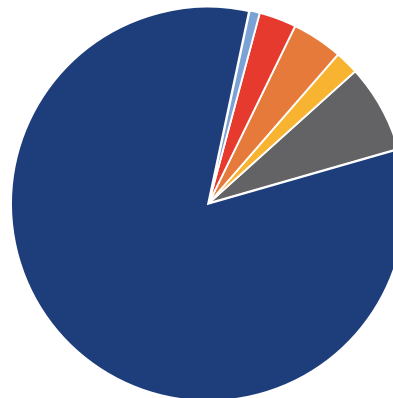

FAMILIES WE SERVE

The statistics below reflect information collected from families seeking child care through Child Care Options.

Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP)

The Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) provides child care subsidies to families that are working, searching for employment, or are in training, as well as families that are enrolled in the Colorado Works Program and need child care services to support their self-sufficiency.

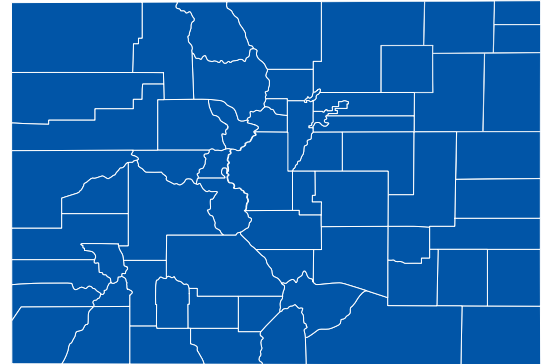

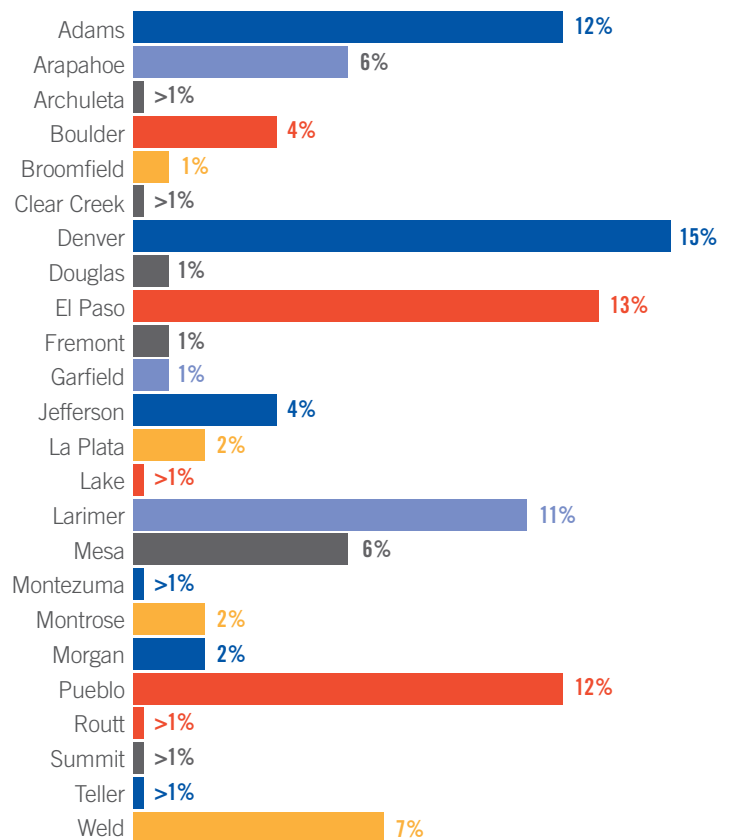
